Additional Considerations for partners of woman in labour that <u>do not</u> have COVID-19 or are PUI

- 1. Partner to accompany patient for the labour and delivery
- 2. Partner may go into theatre for Caesar as per normal
- 3. After delivery
 - a. If patient in a private room with a bathroom partner can stay and not move in or out of the room. (Hospital specific if they can do this)
 - b. If in a general ward, partner can stay with the patient in the general ward for the day, may not walk around or visit the coffee shop, and must leave in the evening.
- 4. **Each hospital to decide what they can and can't do**, partners coming in and out to be discouraged, must remain for the day.

Additional Considerations in Paediatric Patients who are COVID-19 positive needing admission

- 1. Child Positive for COVID-19 or PUI parent will have been in close contact:
 - a. Paediatric Ward
 - i. 'Parent and Child' to be isolated as one unit. Nursing staff to take appropriate IPC precautions when entering the room.
 - 1. Rationale: if you remove the parent the nurse will be more exposed as will be in room all the time and child may be very distressed without a parent.
 - ii. Do not allow additional visitors, and parent may not change unless their own condition changes
 - b. Paediatric ICU/CCU (Child ventilated)
 - i. Parents will not be allowed into the unit to sit with the child
